Job Description

Coaches

- Certification: Coaches will maintain current certification as required by the RI Interscholastic League (RIIL) and the Burrillville School Department.
- Policies: Coaches will comply with all policies and procedures of the RI Interscholastic League (RIIL) and the Burrillville School Department and ensure that all players maintain eligibility requirements as defined by the RIIL and the Burrillville School Department.
- Supervision: Coaches will maintain a safe and healthy practice/game environment before, during and after practice, and will provide appropriate supervision of all activities with the team. Coaches will display – and demand of all athletes - proper etiquette/sportsmanship at all times.
- Communication: Coaches will attend meetings and file game reports/results as required by the RIIL, maintain an honest and open dialogue with the Athletic Director and the Principal, provide athletes with necessary information in a timely manner (i.e. dates of physicals, practice/game schedules, etc.), provide regular and positive contact with parents, and communicate regularly with the media.
- Equipment: Coaches will distribute equipment/uniforms to athletes and ensure proper use of all equipment during the season. At the end of the season, coaches will inventory and store all equipment/uniforms in a secure and pre-approved location and report missing or damaged equipment/uniforms to the Athletic Director.
- Facilities: Coaches will supervise proper use of all facilities, ensure proper sanitary conditions of locker rooms during the season and ensure that all locker areas are completely emptied at the conclusion of the season.
- Recommendations: Coaches will forward recommendations for the upcoming year (i.e. equipment, supplies, budget) and submit nominations for athlete recognition to the Athletic Director at the conclusion of the season.
